On Thursday, my bill <u>SB 392</u>, reported from the House Health and Human Services Committee. SB 392 requires any hospital ER to have at least one licensed physician on duty and physically present at all times. Current law requires such hospitals to have a licensed physician on call, though not necessarily physically present on the premises, at all times.
